Item 7: Homework	Parents have expressed concerns about whether homework is beneficial. It was presented that homework can be an added stress to homelife with no real benefit. A secondary concern with the current homework policy around punishment of children who have not completed their homework, was felt not to be in line with Educate Together child-centred ethos. Current research suggests minimising homework to be more beneficial for child development.	Action: Raymond will bring the concerns of parents to the next staff meeting and board meeting.
Item 8: SWAP Event	Event went well, raised €110. €55 has been sent to Friends of Earth charity.
